3. Verses 7-12 Paul tries to explain once again what is required to be called "children of God." Who are the children of the promise?

4. Why did the Lord love Jacob and hate Esau? Genesis 25:23

5. Verses 14- 21- what do these verses say about God’s purpose for each of us?

6. Verse 22 . . . What do you think it means that God . . . “bore with great patience the objects of his wrath. . . in order to make the riches of his glory known to the objects of his mercy”? Who are the objects of his wrath? Who are the objects of his mercy?

7. Verses 25, 26, 27 and 28.. Paul quote the prophets regarding who the object of God’s mercy are... ? Who does he include?

8. Verses 30 and 31 . . .we see once again the idea that Gentiles have been given the opportunity to become children of God – and Israelites who have had the law for centuries have not attained their goal. Why? What parables of Jesus does this remind you of?

9. Verse 32 : The Jews pursued heaven by works and not faith...and stumbled over what?

10. Verse 33 is taken from Isaiah 8:14 and Isaiah 28:16. . . what is this tested stone? What does this prophecy mean?

11. How did that “stone” cause Israel to stumble?
